Some tips when purchasing outdoor gear:

- Look for rain jackets and rain pants that are "waterproof", not just "water resistant". Check the labels for details such as taped or welded seams and water repellent (polyurethane) treatment.
- Ensure that rubber boots are tall enough to withstand lots of puddle splashing!
- Look for winter jackets, snow pants, and boots with high insulation ratings. We also recommend looking for winter boots that are waterproof for slushy weather
- We have found that mittens generally keep little hands warmer than gloves. Look for mittens that are waterproof and have a good weather rating. Mittens with long, elastic cuffs stay in place well both on top of jackets and tucked in.
